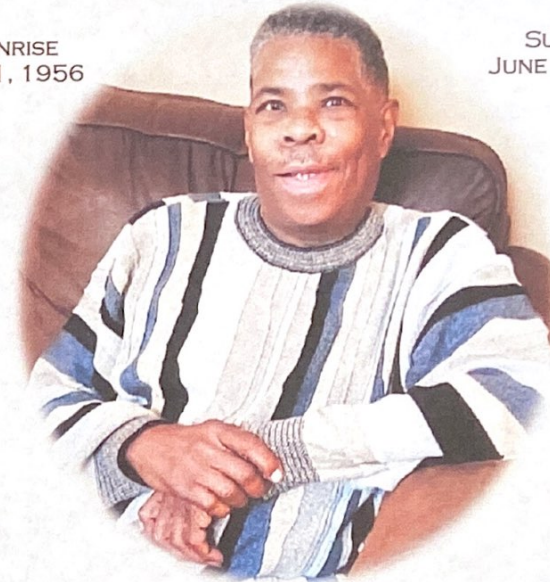

The Obituary

DWIGHT TYRONE HARVEY SR. WAS BORN MAY 1, 1956 IN TOLEDO OHIO TO THOMAS SR. AND WYLMA HARVEY. HE WAS A MEMBER OF MT. PILGRIM BAPTIST CHURCH UNDER THE PASTORSHIP OF REVEREND S.M. COLEMAN FROM A YOUNG AGE. HIS EARLY EDUCATION INCLUDED PICKETT ELEMENTARY AND BEING A GRADUATE OF LIBBEY HIGH SCHOOL'S CLASS OF 1974. HE WAS AN INSPECTOR WITH DOEHLER JARVIS INDUSTRIES FOR 30 YEARS. HE SPENT THE LATTER PART OF HIS ADULTHOOD AND EVENTUALLY RETIRED FROM COYNE DELIVERIES. DWIGHT NEVER MET A STRANGER AND SPREAD HIS CONTAGIOUS PERSONALITY ALL OVER THE CITY ALONG WITH HIS LOVE OF THE CLEVELAND BROWNS AND THE LOS ANGELES LAKERS. ON JUNE 6, 2020 DWIGHT DEPARTED THIS LIFE. HE WAS PRECEDED IN DEATH BY HIS PARENTS AND OLDER BROTHER, ROBERT HARVEY. LEFT BEHIND TO MOURN HIS PASSING ARE HIS SON DWIGHT HARVEY JR (CHEREE) OF TOLEDO, OHIO; GRANDCHILDREN, TERIUS DWIGHT AND ZYEER DWIGHT HARVEY OF TOLEDO; TWO BROTHERS, THOMAS HARVEY JR. (BARBARA) AND HENRY HARVEY OF TOLEDO, OHIO; THREE SISTERS, MARGO HAIRSTON (KIM) OF TOLEDO, OHIO, DEBRA HARVEY OF SANDUSKY, OHIO, AND TERESA ALLISON (REGINALD) OF HOUSTON, TEXAS; NIECES: BOBBETTE, ROBINETTA, SYREETA, SIRITA, ELICIA, ERIKA, ROBYN, DEMETRIA; NEPHEWS: DESHON, VINCENT, THOMAS III, BRANDON, REGINALD AND A HOST OF GREAT NIECES AND NEPHEWS, SPECIAL COUSINS, NEIGHBORHOOD SISTER VAN BENNETT, AND EXTENDED FAMILY AT FRED L'S AND ELK'S LODGE.
