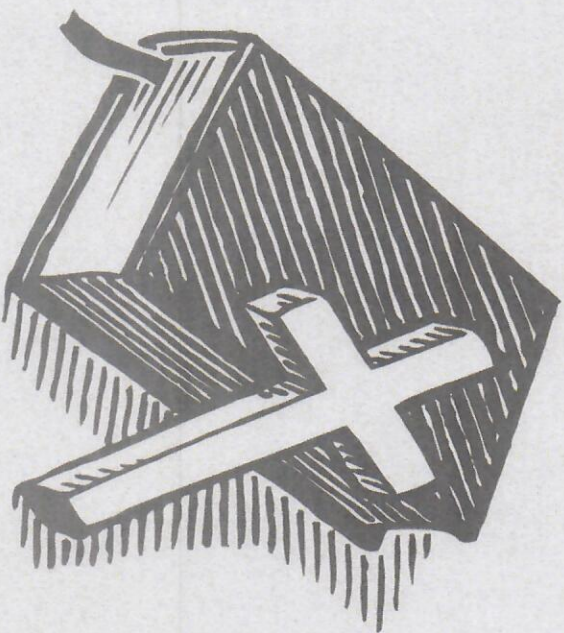


## The Obituary

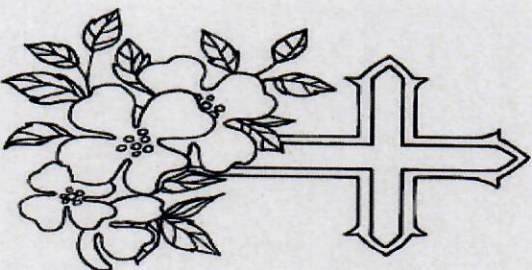
