Mary Alice Pattin, affectionately known as *"MaMa Mary"* was gifted to us on November 28, 1943, in Toledo, Ohio and returned home on March 16, 2021. We were BLESSED with the present of her presence for 77 years. She was born to the union of the late Willie Lee & Nina Mae Pattin. **Mary Alice** attended Gunkel Jr. High and Scott High School.

She loved and accepted the Lord as her savior and was baptized in the name of Jesus Christ.
