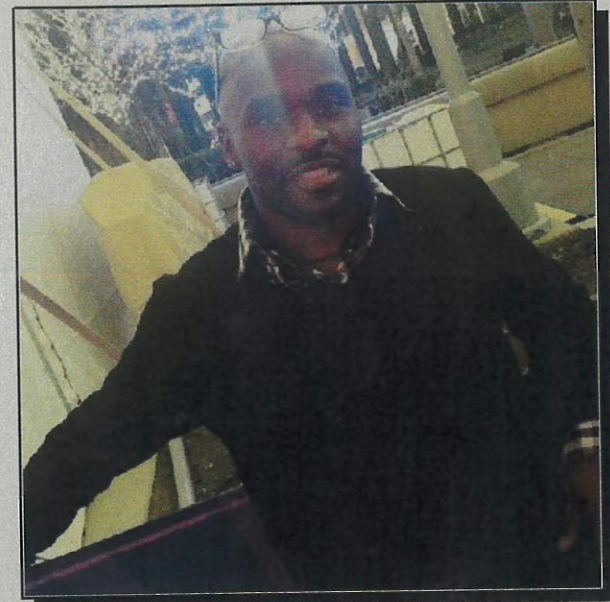

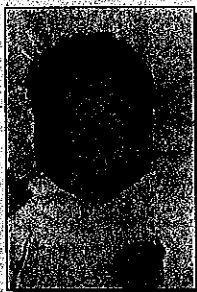

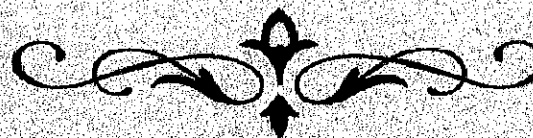
On Sunday, September 18, 2022, Marcus, surrounded by his loving family, left his earthly body and made his transition to his heavenly home.

The memory of you will always linger in my life

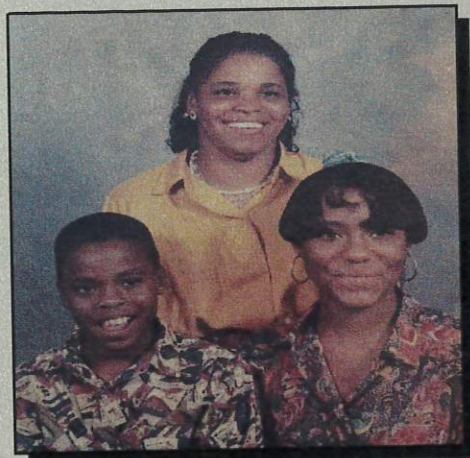
I'm going to miss hearing your voice,
