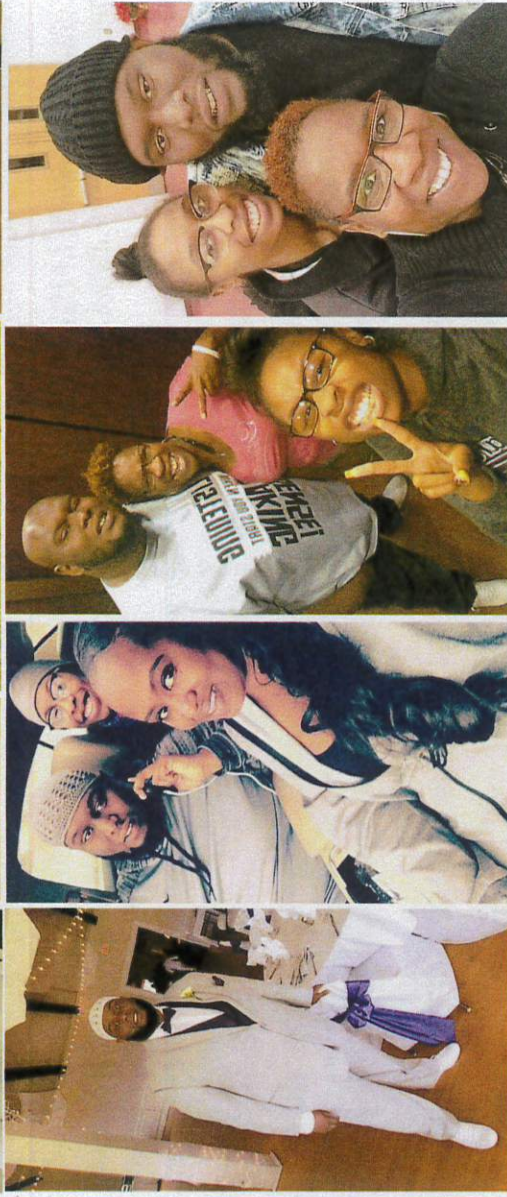

### NOTHING IS LOST FOREVER

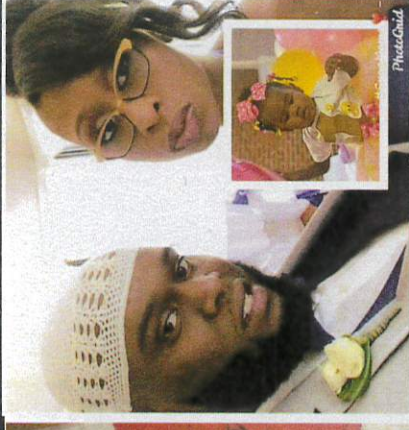
Nothing is lost forever
