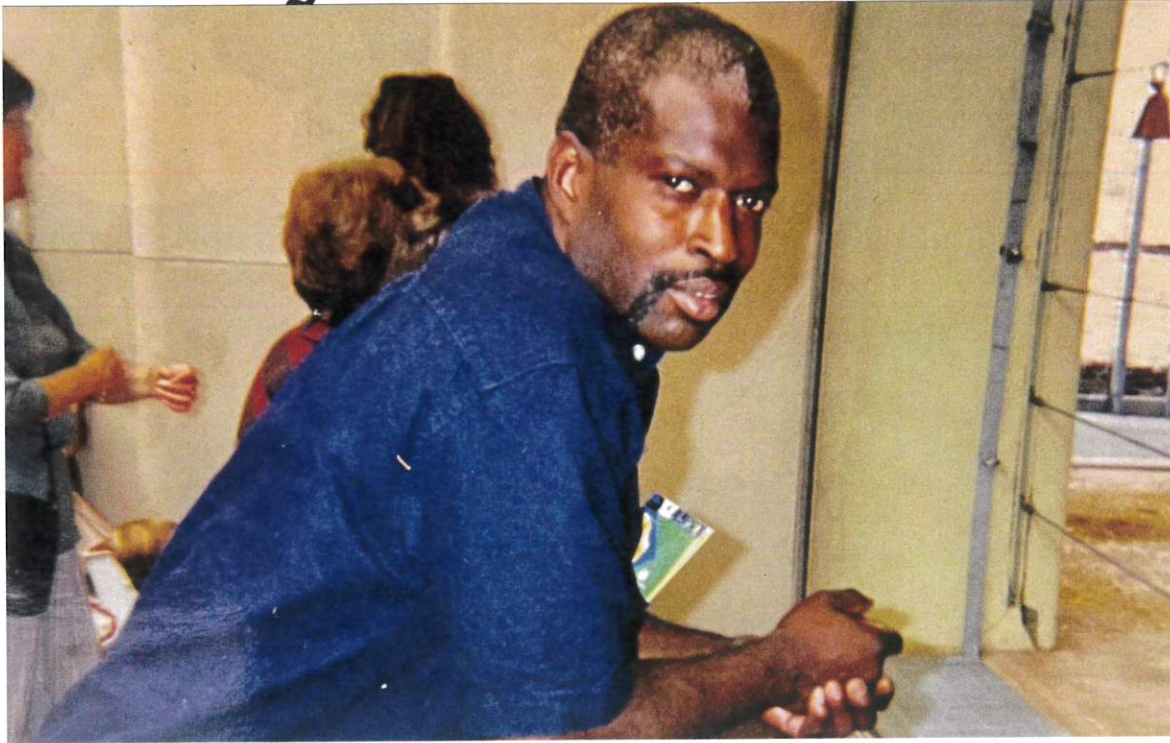


# In Memory of Gary L. Penamon



## OBITUARY
