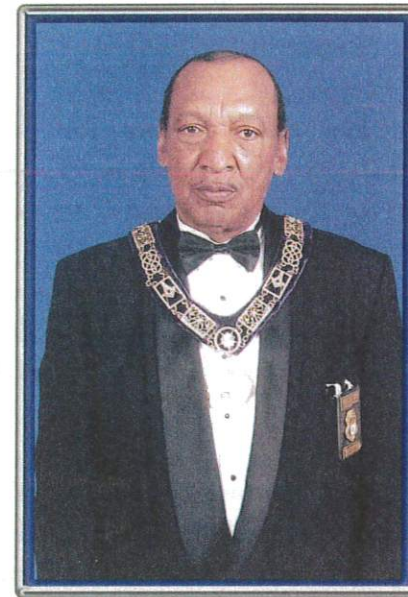

Gerald B. Harris, Sr. was born September 19, 1937, and passed away on April 18, 2023, at the age of eighty-five (85) years old.

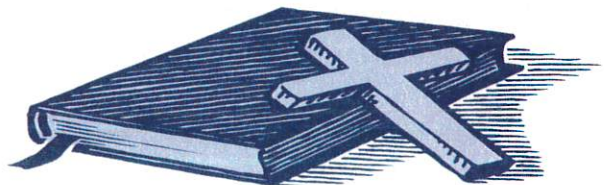
Gerald was born in Covington, Tennessee to the late Essie J. Hicks and William C. Hicks.
